The five-day event includes everything from daily sessions, workshops, conferrals, and celebrations.

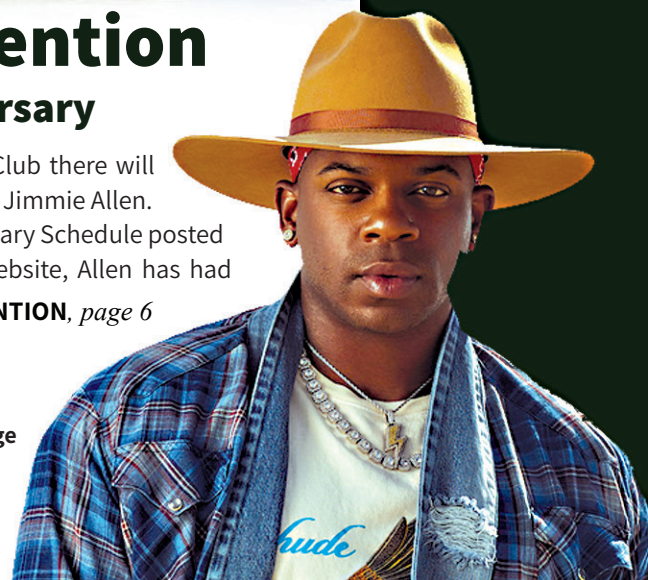
For members of the 25 Club there will be a special performance by Jimmie Allen.
