Dress Code set for Social Quarters and Lodge Home

No clothing with obscene, profane or offensive language or art.

In 1918, Resolution No. 19 was passed authorizing Director General James J. Davis to create the fund.

In 1935, the Moosehaven Endowment Fund was established.

Total contributions to the Mooseheart/Moosehaven Endowment average more than a million dollars per year.

Moose Lodges across the country Endowment fund collections in conjunction with the None O'clock Ceremony.

The Nine O'clock Ceremony gives members the opportunity to reflect upon the value of Mooseheart and serves as a reminder of the principles of The Moose. The Nine O'clock Ceremony shall be performed, and an endowment fund collection conducted, whenever members of The Moose are assembled.

There are a number of other areas where you can donate to Moose Charities.

Twice a year lodges participate in the Rocker Fund and Cradle Fund.

October is "Cradle" month to benefit our children at Mooseheart. In February, we celebrate our seniors at Moosehaven with the Rocker Fundraiser.

All money collected will go into the Endowment Fund. This fund is the security that if anything ever happens to the Moose Fraternity, our seniors and children will continue to be taken care of.

They include Donors Circle, Moosehaven AAA, Moosehaven City of Contentment, M&M Club, Mooseheart Boosters, Mooseheart Child City & School, Matching Gifts and Workplace Giving, Wish List, Planned Giving, Defending Circle Society, League of Guardians, and the Veterans Walk.
