Scott began to look at ways the Moose organization could serve today's families better and provide future funding for Mooseheart and Moosehaven.

The Concept of Lodgic grew from that to become a new type of facility design to meet the needs of today's working families.

Lodgic consists of five key elements to meet those needs.

An affordable flexible workplace for todays independent workers by provid-

ing a variety of different work spaces with flexible plans.

A market place café to provide a good meal on the run or to take home.

Bar and restaurant facilities to provide a warm friendly environment to enjoy with friends or just a night out.

A Kids Kamp to provide flexible, on-demand and play and learn childcare with evening hours available.

Finally, event space to host or hold events for 2 to 125 attendees.
