As we approach Retention Week, I thought it would be a good time to remind you or enlighten you to the purposes of the Moose Fraternity: taking care of our children at Mooseheart and our seniors at Moosehaven. Most of us did not join because of Mooseheart or Moosehaven. It was likely you had a friend that brought you, you liked the dart or pool leagues or even playing cards. Hopefully someone told you about Mooseheart and Moosehaven when you joined. If you joined back when enrollments were required you heard about Mooseheart and Moosehaven through the "Story of the Moose".

Maybe your got your renewal notice and set it aside and forgot about it. Maybe you thought well I do not go to the lodge that often any more, or have not been out for a while, no need to renew.

So, if you are contacted during Retention Week or later asking you to

maintain your membership in the Moose. Take a moment and think about the 200 - 250 children that call Mooseheart home or the 200 - 250 Residents that call Moosehaven home because the majority of your membership dues goes directly to pay the operating costs of both Mooseheart and Moosehaven. If you are a Moose Legionnaire Your addition dues go to funding some important programs on both campuses including Moosehaven Operations, the Moosehaven Senior Medical Fund and Camp Ross a retreat 60 miles from Mooseheart utilized year round by the children of Mooseheart.

The children of Mooseheart are there for many different reasons, parents unable to care for them, a death in the family, abuse in the family or they may have been living in the streets. Whatever the reason they now have a second

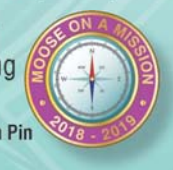

Sign 5 Members

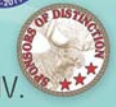
