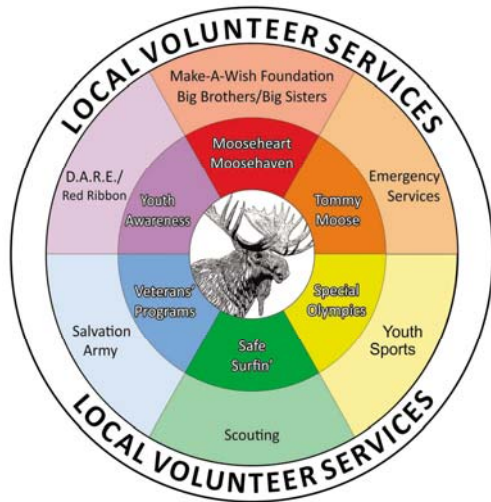
## Woodward to Host OSKMA *(continued from Page 1)*
