You may also be required to submit a new application to the lodge for membership. That equals \$70. If you are in good standing before May 1st, then you won't come due for lodge dues until the expiration date on your card. Then, you will be paying the lodge dues. For every year you pay your lodge dues ON TIME, you will receive a free year of dues in the chapter, up to 3 years.

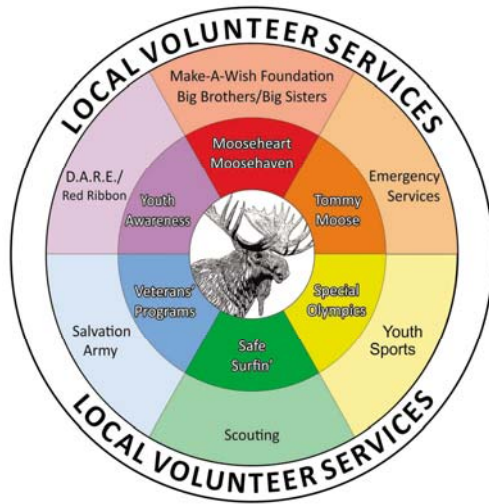
